Eines 49: Europa: un ideal (encara) en construcció (May 27, 2024)

The Fundació Bofill's Social Hub (Barcelona) hosted the presentation of "Eines" journal's 49th issue, featuring a monographic analysis on the need to update the European project in order to face great challenges such as the rise of far-right parties or the climate emergency.

The event included a dialogue between Tomàs Molina, physicist and meteorologist, and Diana Riba, MEP and candidate by Ara Repúbliques coalition.









Eines 50: L'Administració: la transformació inajornable (September 26, 2024)

The Fàbrica Lehmann - Ideograma (Barcelona) hosted the presentation of "Eines" journal's 50th issue, featuring a monographic analysis on how to redesign the Catalan public administration in order to improve its efficiency and meet the citizens' needs.

The event included a dialogue between Laura Vilagrà, vice-president of the Catalan government, and Àngel Castiñeira, professor and director of the ESADE's Chair on Lideratges i Sostenibilitat.

Study: Dones i sequera a la Catalunya rural. Una perspectiva feminista (October 25, 2024)

The Societat Ateneu de Tàrrega (Lleida) hosted the presentation of the report *Dones i sequera a la Catalunya rural. Una perspectiva feminista*, by researcher Ariadna Romans. This report focuses on the experiences of rural women in Catalonia through an intersectional feminist political ecology approach, in order to understand the way drought and the water shortage affects their routine experiences. This work was awarded the Nativitat Yarza Feminist Studies' Scholarship 2023.

The presentation was attended by Ariadna Romans, author of the report; Carme Culleré, Belianes' Mayor; and Núria Bacardit, farmer.











Eines 51: Qualitat democràtica: l'art del bon govern popular (December 10, 2024)

The Espai Línia (Barcelona) hosted the presentation of "Eines" journal's 51st issue, featuring a monographic analysis of how to strengthen democracy in a context marked by the technological revolution and the rise of authoritarianism.

The event included a dialogue between Simona Levi, activist and founder of Xnet; and Raül Romeva, economist, doctor in International Relations and in Education and Sports Sciences, and Fundació Irla's spokesperson.

Josep Irla Opening Lecture 2024-2025 (January 22, 2025)

The Auditorium of Fundació Bofill's Social Hub (Barcelona) was chosen as the site for this course's Opening Lecture. This is an event that opens the political course for Fundació Irla, where we invite international speakers to deliver lectures on political, cultural, social and/or economic topics.

This year's guest speaker was Craig Calhoun, Professor of Social Sciences at Arizona State University, who delivered a lecture on «The persistence of the nation: the national fact in the age of globalization». He analyzed the concept of nationalism and its implications in the age of globalization, in order to prevent to prevent its weaponization by far-right movements and to put at the service of a democratic, inclusive and progressive agenda instead.







Linguistic minoritization: cases, experiences and answers in Europe (January 30, 2025)

The Institut d'Estudis Catalans (Barcelona) hosted a conference organized by Fundació Irla together with Coppieters Foundation and CIEMEN, dedicated to analyzing and discussing the linguistic minorization in Europe based on the Catalan, Icelandic and Ukrainian case.

The event began with the conference «Lanquage as a weapon: Russian nationalism and the roots of the invasion of Ukraine» by Hanna Perekhoda, Ukrainian activist and researcher at the Université de Lausanne. and the conference «Linguistic policies in a context of English linguistic pressure» by Ari Páll Kristinsson, research Professor at Árni Magnússon Institute for Icelandic Studies. This was followed by a roundtable discussion featuring Hanna Perekhoda and Ari Páll Kristinsson together with Iñaki Irazabalbeitia, member of Coppieters Foundation, about the main conclusions of the study «Contra la diglòssia digital» («Against digital diglossia»).

Biography: Hugas i Duran lineages (May 2, 2024)

The Biblioteca Lluïsa Duran de la Bisbal d'Empordà (Girona) was the venue for the presentation of «Hugas i Duran. Dues nissagues republicanes», the biography about Hugas and Duran, two lineages of popular Catalonia that participated in the federal republicanism of Empordà. Biography: Vicent Tomàs i Martí (October 10, 2024)

This new volume of the Biblioteca de l'Esquerra Nacional collection was presented in Betxí (País Valencià). This biographical work revolves around the life of Vicent Tomàs i Martí, doctor, political activist and writer, he participated in the creation of the Agrupació Escolar Nacionalista, Nostra Parla de València and Associació Protectora de l'Ensenyança Valenciana.

The presentation was attended by Òscar Pérez Silvestre, author of the biography; Núria Meneu, Betxí Culture Councilor; Vicent Franch, lawyer and political scientist; and Josep Vall, Fundació Irla's executive director.

Centenary of Jordi Carbonell (December 19, 2024)

2024 was celebrated in Catalonia as the centenary of Jordi Carbonell's birth. Carbonell was a philologist, politician and historical leader of Esquerra Republicana, who devoted his life to fight for Catalonia's freedom as well as for Catalan language. For this reason, Fundació Irla, together with the Institut d'Estudis Catalans (IEC), paid homage to him.

It was attended by Oriol Carbonell, son of Jordi Carbonell; Teresa Cabré, president of the IEC; Nicolau Dols and Mila Segarra, president and vice-president of the Philological Section of the IEC; Josep Lluís Carod-Rovira, philologist and writer; and Raül Romeva, Fundació Irla's spokeperson.

Biography: Jaume Carner (February 27, 2025)

In 2024, it was the 200th anniversary of the birth and 150th anniversary of the death of Josep Anselm Clavé, an activist, musician, poet, journalist, politician and businessman, who fostered the ideals of democracy, republicanism and progress through Catalan cultural landscape, and who brought music and poetry to the Catalan working class. To vindicate his legacy, Fundació Irla organized the «Concert republicà: 200 anys de Clavé», interpreted by the Bruckner Barcelona Choir and presented by Roger Canadell.
